HOW DO I APPLY?

There are 5 easy steps:

- Step 1: Get some information from the Business Development centre in your area and collect the application form.
- Step 2: Attend the information session on how to apply for the grant.
- Step 3: Submit your registration and your application forms before the deadline.
- Step 4: Wait for the result of the evaluation.
- Step 5: After verifying your application and a visit to your business, sign the contract with the BDSC.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

The process between your application and the contract will be approximately 2 months. You will sign a contract for no more an 12 months, if successful.

AND FINALLY ...

If you have any question or doubts about your application, call, email or visit the BDSC in your area. They will do all they can to assist you.

Once you have signed the contract, the BDSC will offer training and provide hands-on support to your business to make sure your project is a success.

If you are not successful this time, do not worry! There will be a second chance in July 2019 for another round of funding (resources permitting).

The Business Development Support Grant Fund is a grant facility operated under the BORESHA programme, implemented by WYG international. The grants are done through the Business Development Support Centres (BDSC) established in the 3 project sites. The project is funded by the EU Emergency Trust Fund for Africa (EUTF).

The overall objective of this Fund is to encourage local economic development, job and wealth creation through the growth and diversification of the local economy.

This will be done by supporting new and existing business initiatives.

WHAT IS IT?

The grant fund has 2 component:

- "Start your business": This is for new (at least 3 months), formal and informal, micro or small businesses, cooperatives, CBO's and NGO's income generation projects and credit and saving associations.
- "Grow your business": This is for small and medium business, existing for at least a year and wanting to expand and grow.
